Construction Engineering Inspector

Key Responsibilities include:

- Perform roadway and structure inspection.
- Support higher level technicians or engineers in areas such as construction inspection, material sampling and testing, and construction traffic control.
- Perform standardized and non-standardized testing and assignments by compiling, analyzing, computing, editing and processing field data.
- Perform minor calculations for survey notes and estimates.

- Knowledge in applying engineering concepts to solve complex problems.
- Ability to provide customer service involving the explaining and resolving complicated engineering concepts to various customer groups.
